Key Events

I am writing to let you know arrangements for some of our key events in the last few weeks of the term.

As previously communicated, on Tuesday 5 July the school has a staff training day. The school will be closed to students.

On Thursday 7 July, we will be hosting a transition day for current Year 6 students who will be joining the school in September.
